FIL/MMF conducts free Health Camp

All the students were distributed medical hygiene kit after the camp.

Geriatric Camp at Kusumbi PHC (Primary Health Centre)

Following the encouraging response from senior citizens to the Geriatric camp held in Satara on June 23rd in Kudal PHC where 394 senior citizens were screened, FIL along with its CSR partner MMF organized a Geriatric Camp at next PHC at Kusumbi, Satara. Elderly people at the camp availed medical diagnosis and curative healthcare services by specialist doctors from Pune's renowned hospitals.

The day-long Geriatric camp saw the participation of 153 senior citizens who were attended by a team of specialist doctors. Ophthalmists, psychologists, general physicians, gynaecologists and dental specialists from Sassoon General Hospital, ENT team from Bharati Vidyapeeth and orthopaedic specialists and physiotherapists from Sancheti Hospital provided their specialized services for the camp. 13 cataract, 12 ENT, 23 dental and 45 skin problems were identified.

FIL and MMF are grateful to the local authorities Dr. Kailash Shinde - CEO, Dr. Bhagwan Pawar - DHO and Pramod Gadikar - CS at Satara for their support and cooperation in response to the appeal for organizing the geriatric camp. FIL/MMF believes that one should be equipped with knowledge and be ready to handle an emergency situation at any time. Hence, FIL along with its CSR arm MMF conducted CPR training in collaboration with Sassoon General Hospital, Pune.

Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) is an emergency procedure that combines chest compressions often with artificial ventilation in an effort to manually preserve intact brain function until further measures are taken to restore spontaneous blood circulation and breathing in a person who is in cardiac arrest.

Sassoon doctors Dr. Yogesh Gawali, Dr. Shinde and Dr. Sancheti conducted practical sessions to demonstrate how an employee suffering with cardiac arrest is to be given medical assistance before an ambulance arrives there by saving one's life. 240 employees attended this training.

FIL/MMF conducted an awareness program to emphasize upon the need of early recognition and direct timely medical treatment for CP problems.

Total of 17 people including special teachers, resource persons and health workers participated in this interactive session on CP. Physiotherapist Dr.Saloni Raje from Sancheti Hospital, Pune addressed the participants imparted knowledge on the early signs of identifying CP signs and guide further to a concerned doctor. As all these people work at grass root level, it is easier for them to convince the parents of CP children to initiate early therapy.

During the session, Dr. Raje also demonstrated basic exercises to be given to spastic CP children. She further provided counselling to the parents on various issues that are dealing with children. The attendees thanked FIL/ MMF for this initiative and knowledge / inputs.

FIL/MMF will strive continuously to spread CP awareness and support CP patients in treatments and surgeries.

The main aim of conference was to exchange views on care of elderly and providing an update with the latest developments in the field of Geriatric Medicine. The theme of this three day conference was "Getting Old is Mandatory, Feeling old is Optional" emphasising the need for a positive and optimistic outlook towards old age.

MMF took an initiative to train ASHA (Accredited Social Health Activists) workers in Geriatric care and 30 ASHA workers to attend the conference. This initiative will enable to create awareness in rural areas and take proper care of old people in villages.

The conference was addressed by Dr. Sandeep Tamane -Member of geriatric society of India, Dr. Sudhir Chavan - Shrimati Kasibai Navale College of Agriculture, Dr. Smita Athavale - Dentist, Dr. Sudhakar Kulkarni - Investment Expert, Dr. Rohini Patwardhan - Geriatric Expert, Dr. Ramesh Godbole - Diabetic Expert and old Marathi Actress Mrs. Sulochana. Expert guidance was provided on the care, diet, to be taken in old age including the financial management. The conference was attended by 270 senior citizens.
