Grocery support to Gram Swaraj Trust

This hostel provides food, shelter and education free of cost to underprivileged boys from 8th to 10th standard.

Gram Swaraj Trust relies on donations to support the school and hostel and had requested FIL/MMF to provide monthly grocery support for the hostilities, which FIL/MMF started support from September Month. Through this initiative children will be provided breakfast, lunch and dinner which would help in their growth and development. School Principal and Trustee mentioned that FIL/MMF previously has supported them through Tree plantations along with Drip Irrigation and RO-Water Cooler. Now through this support the Trust will ensure that the money saved and earned will be used for the betterment of the children.



Finolex Industries Limited and its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation distributed 1000 Ration Kits and Blankets to Masar Village.

On 18th December 2021, 1000 Ration Kits were distributed which includes:

3 KG Rice, 3 KG Wheat flour, 1 Liter edible oil, 500 gram Toor pulse, 250 grams Tea, 1 Blanket were provided to Masar Village's Slum Dwellers and Poor Farmers.

Masar Village Sarpanch and Gram Panchayat Members along with Mr. Mangesh Bhake and Mr. Nitul Barot of FIL/MMF were present for the distribution. Monthly Diabetic Camp at KEM Hospital, Pune

Over the past 7 years, Mukul Madhav Foundation has been working closely with KEM Hospital, Pune to support diabetic patients with regular blood tests and insulin supply. This month, 18 patients were gifted with some relief and support.

FIL/MMF associated with Snehalaya institute in July 2021, an NGO working in Pune for Children (**65 children**) with Cerebral Palsy and are supporting them with various therapies.

Finolex Industries limited and CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation celebrated 3rd Dec World Disabled Day.

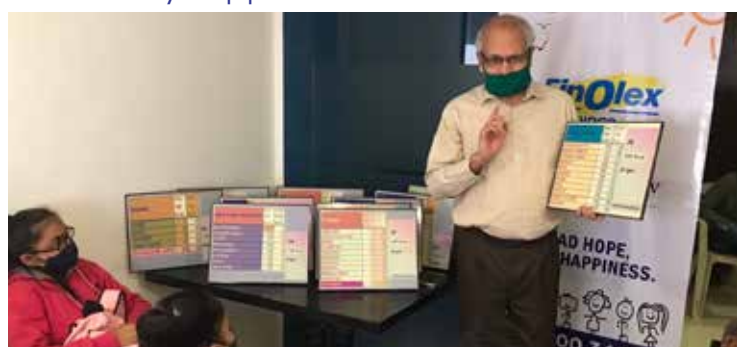

Parents are emotionally overwhelmed and expressed their gratitude towards FIL/MMF for monthly support of Insulin Cartridges and Laboratory support to their children.

Since 2014 with an aim to improve the face of Mental Healthcare in India in collaboration with Concern for Mental Health, UK a registered charity offering training in Mental Health using the World Health Organization (WHO) Mental Health Gap protocols targeting Primary Health Care Physicians, Psychologists, Nurses, Special Teachers, Health Visitors and other Mental Health Professionals have been visiting India to organize training sessions. The trainees are awarded certificates on completion by the World Psychiatric Association. 222 primary Zilla Parishad School Teachers over 2 days to identify students with problems in Mental Health was organized in 2018 with the collaboration of Sassoon General Hospital and CFMH.

This test will be conducted for students of 8th to 12th Graders and all teachers from 2nd to 10th December 2021. The cost per head of this test is Rs. 750/-. The Management has subsidized this rate for students and teachers where students will pay Rs. 100/- and teachers Rs. 250/-, per head and the balance amount will be borne by Mukul Madhav Foundation.

These tests will help in identifying and sharpening areas of improvement with regard to the English language.

The students enjoyed listening to Prof. Dr. Yadav and thanked him for his invaluable guidance.



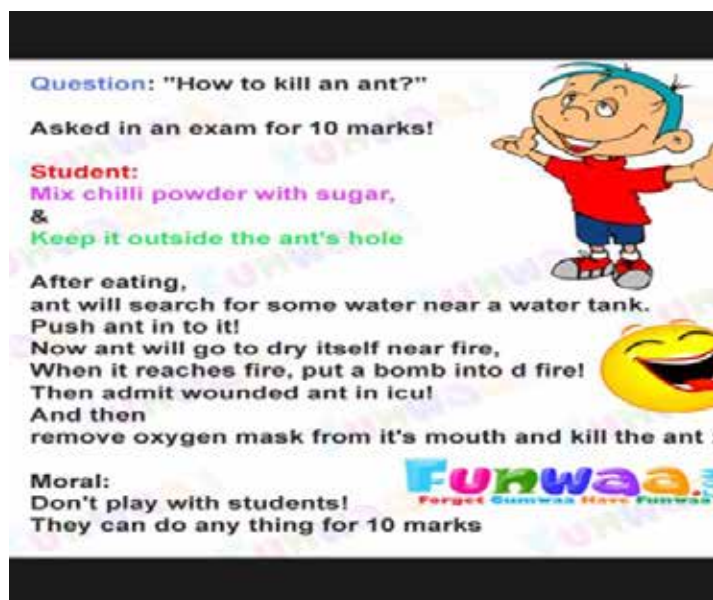
MMV Teacher's Training by Expert academicians from Wisdom World School.
