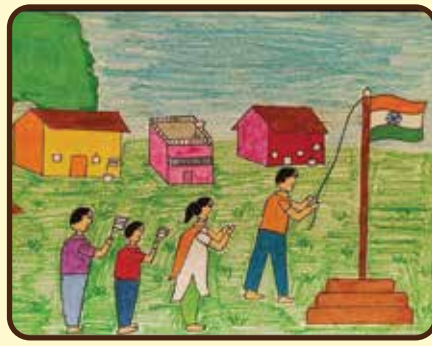
25th November 2022

6th December 2022

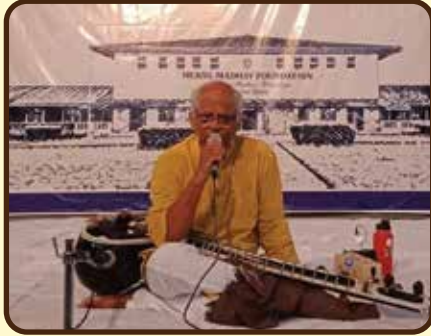
