Teachers' Day was celebrated on 5th September, 2023 at Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya.



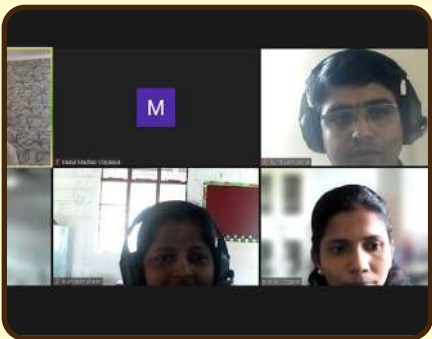
