Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya is actively involved with Nagar Parishad School No.2 in Panchaani, Maharashtra (along with School 1). Amongst the various kinds of support extended since 2012 - infrastructure, sweaters, stationery, teacher salaries - the introduction of Karate was also supported. One of these children, Ms. Diya Kanwadia, who received training in karate at a young age, was inspired and developed a keen interest in martial arts. She pursued the same, and took further training in Sambo (Soviet) Martial Art in Delhi and Rajasthan. Now an ex-student, she recently represented India in the Sambo Asia Oceania Championship held in Macau, China. She clinched a bronze medal for India, breaking a ten-year medal drought for the country. On being felicitated, she thanked the foundation for getting her started on this journey of martial arts. If it wasn't for the karate class introduced in her school, she would never have known the joy of this discipline.

She is now preparing for the 2028 Olympics, and is confident of clinching a medal there. She has all of Nagar Parishad School, every resident of Panchgani, and everybody at Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya cheering for her.









Excellent progress of students supported in Rajasthan.

Mukul Madhav Foundation supports the Education Complex run by Rajasthan Bal Kalyan Samiti (RBKS) in Beeda, Jhadol (Ph), Udaipur, Southern Rajasthan. A Roti Making Machine was donated, along with bedding for the boarders at the hostel. These are being maintained well by the staff there, sending regular reports of the same. The premises are also being ably maintained by the admin. This has created a conducive environment for the students to perform and excel, with exemplary results this year from each and every student.





Cervical Cancer Vaccination Camp at B.T. Shahani School, Pune.

Mukul Madhav Foundation (in collaboration with Finolex Industries) conducted a Cervical Cancer Vaccination Camp at B.T. Shahani School, Pune on 29th June. A total of 148 boys and girls aged 9 to 20 years were vaccinated with informed consent from their parents. This included students from Hindi medium, English medium, and the college sections.

This was conducted in coordination with the Serum Institute, with the Villo Poonawalla Memorial Hospital graciously providing an ambulance and a medical team.

Renovation completed of government school in Rajasthan.

As part of the CSR activities of Finolex Industries Limited, Mukul Madhav Foundation completed the comprehensive renovation of Government Upper Primary School in Badhbaldevpura, Jaipur, Rajasthan. The renovation included classroom and toilet repair, new roof construction, paint, and artwork, installation of a handwashing station, class furniture, water cooler, water purifier, assembly platform, and boundary upgrade with interlocking tiles.









Holistic Child Development Program launched in Meghalaya.

Mukul Madhav Foundation signed an agreement on 8th July with Learning Link Foundation for a Holistic Child Development Program, as a CSR project for Finolex Industries Limited. This program will work with 1000 children in grades 1 to 5, across 10 government schools in Rongram Block of West Garo Hills district of Meghalaya State. With the express purpose of improving foundational literacy and numeracy skills through a structured curriculum, with in-school remedial teaching for slow learners, while simultaneously improving awareness of health, hygiene, well-being, development of life skills, physical development through sports (Khelo India Curriculum), and appreciation of art education. Offering students from this rural background a well-rounded education that they would otherwise never find access to.





Stationery support for Children in Dharashiv, Osmanabad.

An individual donor, Yasmin Vakil, gifted 31 children of widows, in Dharashiv, Osmanabad, with educational kits in loving memory of Shahrukh Marzban Cooper. This community is a part of an on-going engagement with Mukul Madhav Foundation.

Tree plantation at various schools.

Several trees were planted on 13th July in Masar Village, Gujarat at Gram Swaraj Uttar Buniyadi Hostel, Vadu High School, Mahuvad and Mujpur Primary School, and Narsinhpura Primary School, On 22nd July, trees were also planted at Government Upper Primary School in Kotkhawda, Jaipur, Rajasthan. At Shree Sagar Vidhyalaya, Gayapura Village and Sadra Primary School on 23rd July.









E-learning equipment to impact 350 girl students.

Mukul Madhav Foundation and its CSR collaborator Finolex Industries Limited installed new E-learning equipment at Kanya Vidya mandir in Sajani Kolhapur, impacting 350 girl students by aiding their educational journey with access to advanced educational resources.
