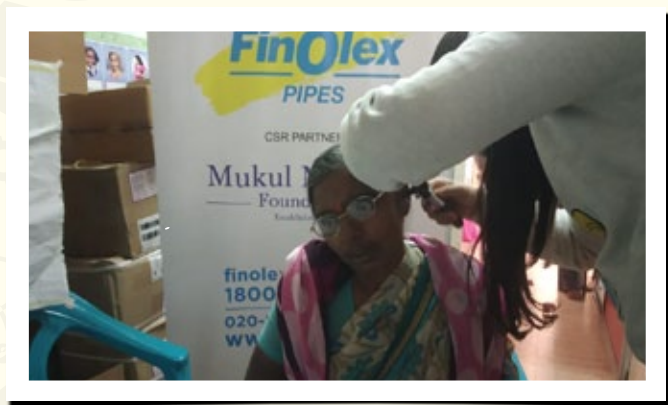
## Geriatric camp at Satara – Primary Health Centre (PHC) Bavdhan, Wai

31st January 2020

FIL/MMF conducted 11th Geriatric camp at Satara, PHC Bavdhan, Wai. Total of 147 Senior Citizens were screened for eye, dental, skin and ENT related issues. Diagnosis has been as follows:

- 7 for cataract surgery,
- 10 for dental treatment,
- 11 patients will be provided with required hearing aid,
- 37 spectacles will be given,
- 98 patients were given physiotherapy and orthopedic treatment,
- 7 patients for skin disease.
- Total 145 patients' blood testing and BP has-been checked.

DHO Dr Atavale, THO Dr Madhav were present at the camp and they appreciated the support extended.

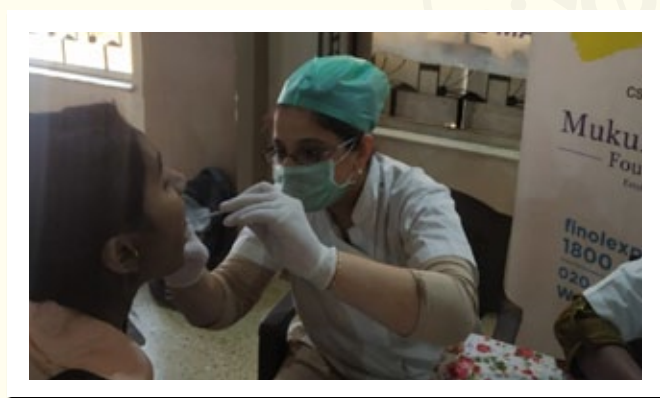


## Health camp at BT Sahani Navin Hind School and Jr. College, Pune

Team from Concern for Mental Health UK was invited to impart their expert knowledge and conduct workshop to train primary healthcare physicians, psychologists, nurses, special teachers and mental health professionals.

This was the 6th Edition of the training which was attended by 100 such participants. So far 650 trainees have been trained in last five years through this initiative. The trainees were awarded with the certificates on completion which carried 5.5 hours of CME points recognized by the World Psychiatric Association.

## Solar Water Pumping System to Panvadi Village

14th February 2020

FIL/MMF signed a MoU with Science and Technology Park- Pune for providing Solar Water Pumping System of 25 HP capacity to pump water from lower dam to the upper dam for recycling and due for inauguration on 4th March 2020.

This provision will help in providing a renewable cost-effective pumping solution to the villagers of Panvadi for the water recycling project. This will benefit the population of Panvadi which is approximately 650 consisting of around 250 households in four Vadis (Blocks) of the villages.

Total 108 ASHA attended training session on Breast cancer & Vasectomy. They have also undergone the Breast cancer screening test. One ASHA is suspected for future follow up.



## Monthly Diabetic Camp, KEM Hospital, Pune

22nd February 2020

FIL and MMF have been supporting monthly Diabetic at KEM hospital over the last 8 years. Blood tests, medications and other support needed is identified with individual patients who are visiting this camp.

This month 13 patients underwent routine blood sugar testing and 16 were provided insulin.



## Updates from Ratnagiri

### Health Camp follow up & Spectacles Distribution.

4th February 2020

For the past 12 years, MMF has been conducting health camp bi-annually to ensure well-being of school students in and around the rural areas of Ratnagiri. This year as part of



the same initiative along with FIL, we organized our 24th medical health camp. The health camp was conducted in the Neware, Dhamanase, Kotawade, Basni, Phansop, Khedshi, Gaonkhadi highschool, ZP schools of Gaonkhadi and ZP schools of Purnagad . MMF is not only conducting the health checkups during the health camps but also ensures the post treatment for those having health issues identified during these health camps. As a part of the same initiative we distributed 38 spectacles to the concerned students of the above mentioned schools. These spectacles were provided from H.V. Desai eye hospital, Pune. We also arranged informative talks about Health Hygiene and Nutrition and lectures focusing need for giving attention towards Dental health. Also we organized speech therapy screening sessions for students having speech related issues.



## Support to Self Help Groups

19th February 2020

FIL/MMF had appealed to local Self Help groups to come forward and make earning with our help.

Ashradevi Ladies Group from Pawas village and Yashashri Self Help Group, Maglad, Ratnagiri has responded positively. This groups has 10 members. They have been providing mid-day meal to the local school and also making food products on demand and supply basis. They came forward with a proposal to make Brooms from coconut fronds. Accordingly we provided dried fallen coconut fronds and they made brooms from the mid-rib sticks of





the fronds. This broom is in demand in local market costing Rs. 50 per broom. Since this utilizes garden waste from FIL plant, there is no cost involved. A truck load of fronds makes about 40 brooms. They sale these brooms for Rs.45 to 50 each in local market. Considering their time and efforts they earn about Rs. 20 per broom. The women are happy and have thanked FIL/MMF for their backing and support.

## 332 toilets built for tribals

Move will help lowering health issues: Collector

**PUNE:** Providing sanitation facilities to tribal villages will help lowering health issues, said Dr Kailas Shinde, Collector of Palghar District. Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation have built 332 toilets in Palghar.

**SANITATION FACILITIES**

"A village like Mahabaleshwar tops as the cleanest village and at the same time, there are few villages in Maharashtra that do not even have toilets, which is a big contradiction. There are many government schemes but somehow some of them do not reach the tribal villages. Lack of toilet fa-

cilities lead to poor hygiene, especially amongst women, girls and children. In these circumstances, Finolex and Mukul Madhav Foundation have built 332 toilets. Their work is quite appreciable," said Dr Kailas Shinde, Collector of Palghar District.

He was talking during the inauguration ceremony of toilets built by Finolex and Mukul Madhav Foundation in collaboration with Yuva Parivartan and other like-minded corporates. These toilets are designed in an eco-friendly manner. Each individual toilet is provided with solar light.

While talking about this venture, Managing Trustee of Mukul Madhav Foundation Ritu Chhabria said, "To benefit Adivasis, we have been working with

like-minded organisations. ZF Gears, Hinduja Leyland Finance have been helping a lot. We are trying to educate people against open defecation."

Vice President of Finolex BR Mehta said, "Lack of hygiene causes many diseases, which results in economical and psychological challenges rural citizens have to face. In the sixth phase, 127 more toilets will be built, bringing the total to 459."
