Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya students shine in World's biggest English Language International Olympiad

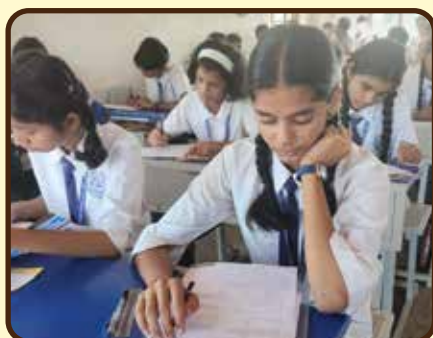


Silver Zone Foundation is reckoned as the organiser of one of the biggest and most popular International Olympiads.

A picnic at Bhatye beach was arranged for the disabled children from the Cerebral Palsy Centre located in Finolex Colony, Zadgaon, Ratnagiri by Mukul Madhav Foundation and Finolex Industries Limited. 73 students from 10th and 12th Standard accompanied them voluntarily in their happiness supporting a social cause under Mission Cerebral Palsy.

Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation have been running a rehabilitation centre for disabled children under Mission Cerebral Palsy from past Seven years.
