COVID-19 RELIEF EFFORTS

Over the last few months, our team has been working relentlessly to support the society in the time of a global health pandemic through the support of Finolex and other amazing donors.

Oiling the Vaccination Wheel

Continuing the COVID vaccination awareness drive under the guidance of The Governor of Gujarat which was implemented by a local NGO called Yuva Unstoppable, in partnership with FIL/MMF Industries supported a total of 18,000 beneficiaries with an incentive of *a litre* of cooking oil as a token of encouragement and appreciation for getting vaccinated.

Distributing smiles, Spreading positivity

1. FIL/MMF in collaboration with Yuva Vikash Kendra, distributed 600 dry ration kits to 11 tribal villages of Tripura on the borders of North East India. The beneficiary and the ground implementation partner expressed their gratitude towards this event.







2. FIL/MMF reached Leh during this pandemic to support Mahabodhi International Meditation Centre (MIMC) with oxygen concentrators and other medical essential items.

During the first wave of Covid, FIL/MMF supported MIMC at Leh by providing them financial assistance to support senior citizens.

Through a unique initiative, Give With Dignity ration kits were distributed to *500 needy tribal families* in Leh.



During the second wave of Covid the following items had been sent to Leh & distributed on 27th August, 2021.

- 4 Oxygen Concentrators
- Medical kits comprising of 250 masks, 250 glovers, 2 thermo scanners, 2 pulse oxymeters and 300 paracetemol strips in each box.
- 400 PPE kits
- 25 Face Sheilds
- 350 beanies



Flood Relief drive for the people of Konkan.

Mukul Madhav Foundation extended its support towards flood-affected areas of Konkan & Western Maharashtra from 20th July, 2021.

In response to various appeals received, with proper due diligence and verification MMF team with the support of Finolex Industries supported 35+ villages close to 11,827 families with relief material & 500 students with educational support.





Kindness Kits & Essential Support

1. Supported *9 villages* in Tal. Mahad, Dist. Raigad, Maharashtra with *700 Grocery kits* with the support of Mr. Raj Deshmukh from Jagruti Group along with his friends



2. Supported Chiplun and surrounding villages by distributing 6000 Water bottles, 1200 Dry snack packs, 800 Solapuri Chadders. Distribution was done under the guidance of Chiplun's MLA Mr Shekhar Nikam and President of Municipal Council Surekha Kherade. The MLA and the Municipal President



3. Donated *15 tarpaulins* to the poor farmers of village Bhambarde & Vegare in Tal. Mulshi, Dist. Pune who lost their roofs in heavy rains



4. MMF along with like minded donors with the support of ground partner Mahatma Gandhi School,Nashik distributed 300 Ration Kits to needy widows at Vadarwadi, Peth Road, Nashik, Maharashtra



5. MMF supported Mahad and surrounding villages in collaboration with Creative Foundation trustee - Mr Sandeep Khardekar by distributing *200 grocery kits*. The Flag off was done under the President of BJP Maharashtra and MLA Shri Chandrant Dada Patil



6. In response to the appeal received from Maharashtra Pradesh Mahila Congress Committee, FIL/MMF has supported flood affected villagers from Wai in Satara Dist., Palus in Sangli, Shirola in Kolhapur with 1000 blankets. KCB member Ms. Pooja Anand accepted it from the MMF office.





7. FIL/MMF supported Dudhgaon, a small village in Tal. Mabaleshwar, Dist. Satara by providing *blankets & ration kits for 75 families* which can feed them for the next 15 days. Our team reached the village Manghar on Tapola road & villagers came walking 4/5 kms to collect the kits because the approach road also vanished in the rains. Villagers were very happy for this support in-spite of all natural hurdles.



8. FIL/MMF supported Flood affected villages Jambhali, Paratwadi, Kolo Wasti & Adivasi pada in Tal. Wai. By providing *ration kits to the 150 farmers families* which can support them at least for 2 weeks till things are back to normal. Yesterday our local rep Mr. Santosh Shelar distributed kits along with Mr. Ashtaputre, a social activist from Pune.



9. Supported Jeevan Aasha Charitable Trust, Mumbai to help 300 villagers in village Gaurwad, tal. Shirol, Dist. Kolhapur. The village is situated on the bank of river Krishna & badly suffered due to heavy rains & overflowing of river Krishna. FIL / MMF supported them with the *grocery worth Rs. 1,50,000/-*. Jivan Aasha Trust contributed towards blankets, Chatais & other essentials.



10. Finolex Industries limited and Its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation supported 190 families affected by cloud burst. with grocery KITs. In Shevgaon block 10 villages were affected by flood. These villages were in need for essentials like clothes / food / dry ration to survive. FIL/MMF took action on appeal received from the Tahasildar of Shevgaon block and verified the ground situation of Vadule village.


