Supporting Thalassemia

Mukul Madhav Foundation has conducted screening camps at 7 colleges in Pune, total students attending the screening camp were 1200+, total blood testing done is 1000+ and identified 27 Thalassemia minor students, we have conducted counseling sessions for all minor students in collaboration with Dr. Nita Munshi, Dr. Liza Bhusare and Dr. Shweta.

On 15th May 2023, Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation conducted a camp at Dr. DY Patil Medical College for first year students of MBBS, a total of 242 students attended the camp, total 100 blood testing done (CBC, HB-electrophoresis, and sugar).

On 26th May all students have received their certificates and have got their placements in various hospitals.

Refreshing lives

Due to the geographical constraints availability of potable water is acute. Hence water to the doorstep is provided from the source with the help of 2 water tanks of 5000 liters' capacity mounted on trucks. Approx. 600 families were able to get the water through this scheme at their doorsteps in summer.

On 4th May this initiative was inaugurated at Phansop village. Sarpanch of Phansop and Bhatye villages, government authorities, Gram Panchayat members, villagers, representatives of Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation were present on this occasion.



Imbibing Nutrition



Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation joined hands in March 2023 with the Vadodara District TB Department for support with Nutrition Kits for 6 months. Kanzasat, Mobha and Sandhi PHCs of Padra taluka, about 82 TB cases have been identified and the government gives medicine to the patients, but if the patients take nutritious food along with the medicines, they will cure early and recurrence will be less. Nutrient Kits as suggested by the TB District Department are 1 KG Toor Dal, 1 KG Moong, 1 KG Groundnut, 1 KG Jaggery, 1 KG Chana, 1 Litre Edible Oil, 400 Gram protein milk powder & 1 KG Dates.

Mission Cerebral Palsy

A total of 67 patients with cerebral palsy, mental retardation, autism, multiple disabilities, hearing impairment, down syndrome, and intellectual disability were assessed at the camp. Based on doctors' recommendations, Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation will provide support for their further treatment and therapy.

Additionally, Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation signed an agreement with Sharda Social Welfare Trust to establish a CP Center where children can receive regular therapy from therapists. SSWT will also involve these children in vocational training and special sports participation at national and international levels.



Joining Families

Bariya Samaj organized a mass wedding (Samuhik Vivha) for 43 couples from underprivileged communities in Padra Block, near the Finolex Industries Masar Plant. They requested support from Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation for these couples. Securing Wellness

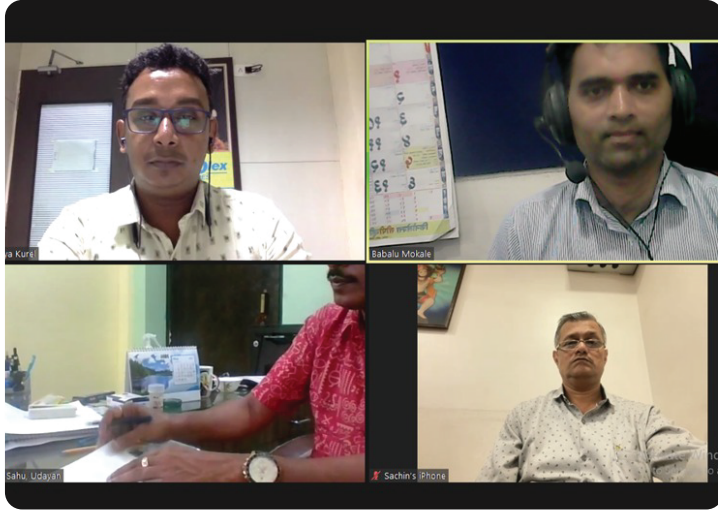

In the presence of CEO Miss Sukhada Khisti and Coordinator, staff member of Connecting Trust and Mukul Madhav Foundation team.

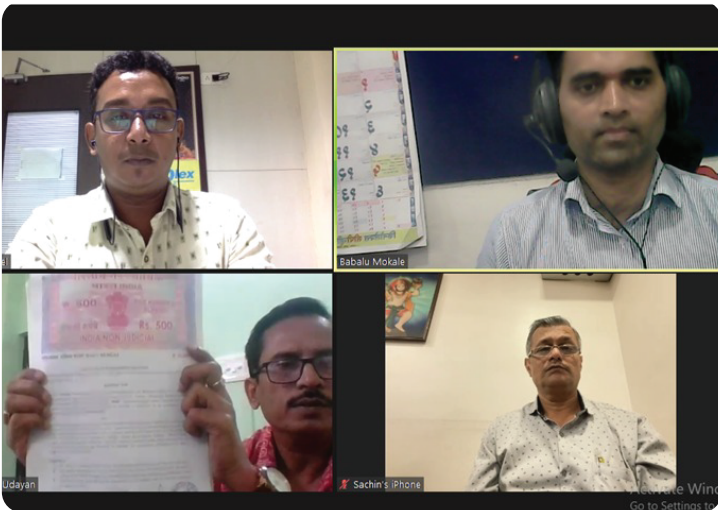


Support to 15 Udayan Children with Leprosy background in Kolkata

In 2022 Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation supported 10 children from 4th to 8th STD and this year we have increased 5 students from 1st to 3rd standard, a total of 15 students are supported for uniforms, bags, shoes. With the collaboration of Udayan- Rising above Leprosy organization in Kolkata, West Bengal working towards the care and development of children with a leprosy background.



Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation supports these children to bring the children out of degrading living conditions and keeps away from the social binding of stigma about the disease 'Leprosy'.

To expand our services to services more and more children with CP at remote areas of Khandala block of Satara district. Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation signed an agreement with Physiotherapy department of Bharati Vidyapeeth, Pune in Feb 2022.

Celebration of 6th Anniversary of Mission Cerebral Palsy in Ratnagiri

Finolex Industries Ltd. and CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation have been running Mission Cerebral Palsy for disabled children for the past 8 years.

Mukul Madhav Foundation started the mission Cerebral Palsy in 2015 and provided physiotherapy, speech therapy, and occupational therapy to children with cerebral palsy in Satara and expanded the project to Ratnagiri district and moved to Masar, Gujarat.

The project started with assessment camps, the donation of wheelchairs and commode chairs for children, and the establishment of rehabilitation centers with regular physiotherapy and speech therapy services for their betterment.

In April 2017 CEO of Zila Parishad Ratnagiri saw the work of Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation in Satara for Children with Cerebral Palsy and invited Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation to start this Mission Cerebral Palsy initiative in Ratnagiri.
