Dr. Anil Kumar Satapathy conducts extra lecture for Junior College students

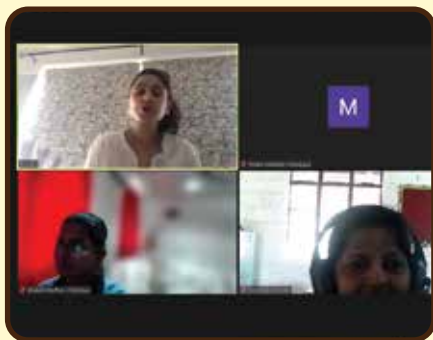
