Dialysis support at JanKalyan Samiti Dialysis center at Seva Bhavan,Pune. 3 October, 2023

RSS Jankalyan Samiti (Maharashtra Prant), is a Charitable Trust, working for the last 50 years (Since 1973) in the field of Disaster Management, Health, and Education in Maharashtra. Disaster Management is one of the important verticals of Jankalyan Samiti's service to society. An appeal was received from them to support one of their projects - Jan Kalyan Samiti Dialysis center at Seva Bhavan, Pune. This Seva Bhavan has been created to support healthcare initiatives, accommodation and food for patients' families, and facilitate training for social workers specially on disaster management.



Mukul Madhav Foundation has responded to the request to support the dialysis center, and did so with 6 beds and 6 dialysis machines. The funds allocated are approximately Rs. 44 lacs. These will ensure that patients can do tests at an affordable and subsidised rate of Rs 750.

Though this centre has been functional since 15th August 2023, it was inaugurated on 2nd October 2023 at the hands of Dr. Dhananjay Kelkar, medical director of Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital, Pune & in the presence of Dr. Pravin Dabadghav who is a chief of the western Maharashtra for Rashtriya Seva Samiti.

This is the second centre we are supporting along with the other Dialysis Center at Jejuri Devasthan in Jejuri, Pune. All the dignitaries who were present for the occasion appreciated the benefits which are now possible with these equipment.

Club foot distribution in Sir Takhtasinhji General Hospital, Bhavnagar, 5th October, 2023

Mukul Madhav Foundation, collaborated with Cure International India (CIIT) in supporting the differently-abled over the last decade. An appeal was received in year 22-23 from Club Foot India which we responded to and we are now supporting a total of 110 children in Gujarat, Telengana and Tamil Nadu.

In year 23-24 we received an appeal from Cure India International for the support of 60 children in collaboration with the Hinduja Foundation and Finolex industries Limited.

On 5th October 2023, Mr Rakesh Patel and Mr Varun Sarhawara of Finolex Industries Ltd, visited General Hospital Deesa Banaskantha in Gujarat.

They met 8 children and their parents, and had a discussion about the treatment procedure, listening to parents as they shared their experience and expressed gratitude.

Club Foot India was established with the purpose to treat clubfoot, support families and inspire action to eradicate disabilities caused by Clubfoot. Established in 2009, their work involves working for children through Government partnerships.

Collaboratively we aim to support children with disabilities so that they can lead a life of dignity.

Club Foot is a birth defect in which the foot is twisted out of shape or position.

The cause of clubfoot is unknown. Babies with clubfoot are usually otherwise healthy.

In clubfoot, the foot appears twisted and can even look as if it's upside down. Despite its appearance, clubfoot itself doesn't cause any discomfort or pain.

Treatment is usually successful. It includes stretching and casting (Ponseti method) or stretching and taping (French method). Sometimes, surgery is required.

We participate in this fair every year by supporting various NGOs who showcase their products here. This year, various items like candles, bags, homemade pickles, local delicacy flour, handicrafts, earthen lamps, lights and other items procured from 7 state and 13 self help group were showcased at the fair.

Today, 8 years down the line, we have assessed over a thousand children, established nine Cerebral Palsy Rehabilitation Centres, and managed to provide a ray of hope in the lives of parents and children who previously had to travel miles to access adequate healthcare. Total 3000 senior citizens were served a hearty breakfast through the help of Ganesh Krida Mandal Pune (Anand Melava).

Pune's Thalassemia Society honoring Mrs. Ritu Praksh Chhabria, 11th October, 2023

Thalassemia Society of Pune chapter felicitated Mrs Ritu Praksh Chhabria for completing 25 years of Philanthropy work and social services.

Mukul Madhav Foundation has been partnering the Thalassemia Society of Pune chapter since 2018, with medicine and filters, supporting a total of 108 patients per month.

Seeing the difference early diagnosis makes, we started conducting thalassemia awareness sessions and screening camps at various colleges. Till date Mukul Madhav Foundation has conducted many such thalassemia awareness sessions with screening camps in 11 colleges in Pune and Ratnagiri, with a total of 1500+ students attending. We completed 1100+ blood tests and identified 27 minor students, and we provided counseling to all minor students in collaboration with Dr. Nita Munshi, Dr. Liza Bhusare, and Dr. Shweta.



Support to Senior Citizens and Girls in Remand Home in Ratnagiri, 14th October, 2023

Mukul Madhav Foundation continue to support senior citizens and girls in Remand Home, Lanja, Ratnagiri. Mukul Madhav Foundation has been supporting senior citizen homes and fulfilling their various needs over the last few years. We responded to an appeal for support in monthly grocery from Arunashram, an old age home in Lanja which also houses 12 orphans. In addition, we also responded to an appeal to support Jankibai Tendulkar girls' Remand home with sanitary napkins for 45 girls.

Mr. Devendra Patil, coordinator of this old age home, Dy. SP of Rajapur and Lanja, Mr. Yashwant Kedge, old age home residents, Ms. Vidya Belvalkar, instructor of the girls remand home and Mr. Shivgen, coordinator of Remand home attended this function and appreciated the generous and timely response of Mukul Madhav Foundation and expressed their heartfelt gratitude.



Support with CCTV Cameras for Educational Empowerment to St. Crispin Home in Pune, 16th October, 2023

Mukul Madhav Foundation supports St. Crispin Home in Pune. St. Crispin Home is a Pune-based organization working for orphans and single-parent girls, providing education from 1st to 10th class, alongwith a hostel facility. They house a total of 150 girls in the age range of 6 to 15 years. In 2022 we received an appeal from St. Crispin home for 42 CCTV cameras and monthly groceries for the children, which Mukul Madhav Foundation initiated after all verifications and due diligence. This year, St. Crispin Home requested for an additional 17 cameras for their classrooms, which Mukul Madhav Foundation approved and installed in October 2023. Today on 16th Oct, 2023 Mukul Madhav Foundation officially handed over the cameras in the presence of Mr. Vishram Bhawe, Director and AMs. Alka Chandulkar Superintendent from St. Crispin Home along with Mr. Jadhav from team Mukul Madhav Foundation

Empowering Rural Entrepreneurs with Honey Bee-Keeping Programs in Maharashtra, 17th October 2023

Support Tribal and Rural Farmers with Honey Bee-keeping program for entrepreneurship development. Mukul Madhav Foundation, joined hands with Maharashtra Khadi Gramodyog Mandal to uplift tribal women with the Bee-Keeping Initiative in Maharashtra.

Mukul Madhav Foundation started a Honey bee-keeping project in June 2021 in Bhimashankar and supported 17 farmers, with an additional 47 farmers in May 2022 from Mokhada Palghar. This collaboration has supported and enhanced livelihood opportunities for women in rural Maharashtra.

With an aim to provide advanced training to rural women to become self-sustainable by enhancing their skills in tailoring, fashion designing and nursing a skilling centre was inaugurated in collaboration with Yuva Parivartan. MMF has been associated with Yuva Parivartan since 2021. Yuva Parivartan Academy is working to provide high quality courses through the Skill India and National Skill Development Corporation.

Mukul Madhav Foundation in association with Yuva Parivartan Manch started a project of imparting training of making candles and incense sticks to the CP affected children and to their parents with the help of experts so that they may become self sustainable and can generate a source of income in 2022. Thalassemia and Diabetes Screening Campaign in Schools and Colleges, 21st October, 2023

Awareness and screening of Thalassemia and Diabetes in schools and colleges

Supporting children with Thalassemia in collaboration with The Wishing Factory Masar, Gujarat, Thalassemia Society of Pune Chapter, Bharati hospital and The Indian Red Cross Society in Pune Maharashtra.

We began this with the support of Dr Nita Munshi, who is Director Laboratory at Ruby Hall Clinic, Pune and Dr C S Yajnik, Director Diabetes Unit at KEM Hospital Pune.

As on date we have completed screening camps in 12 colleges in Pune, Ratnagiri and Satara with a total of 2092 students attending and providing consent for screening for thalassemia and diabetes.

1807 blood samples have been collected and 37 minors have been identified. Students were provided counselling and prognosis thereafter.



On 21st October 2023 Mukul Madhav Foundation organized a Thalassemia and Diabetes awareness session and blood tests camp at the Bel-Air hospital. 200+ students attended this event and 192 blood tests were performed (CBC, HB- electrophoresis, and sugar).

Dr. Sweta Lunkad - Hematologist and Bone Marrow Transplant Physician Pune, and Dr Nileema Nagkar, KEM Hospital Pune were the speakers for this session.

Empowering Rural Women for Sustainable Development in Khandala Blocks of Satara District, Maharashtra. 21st October, 2023

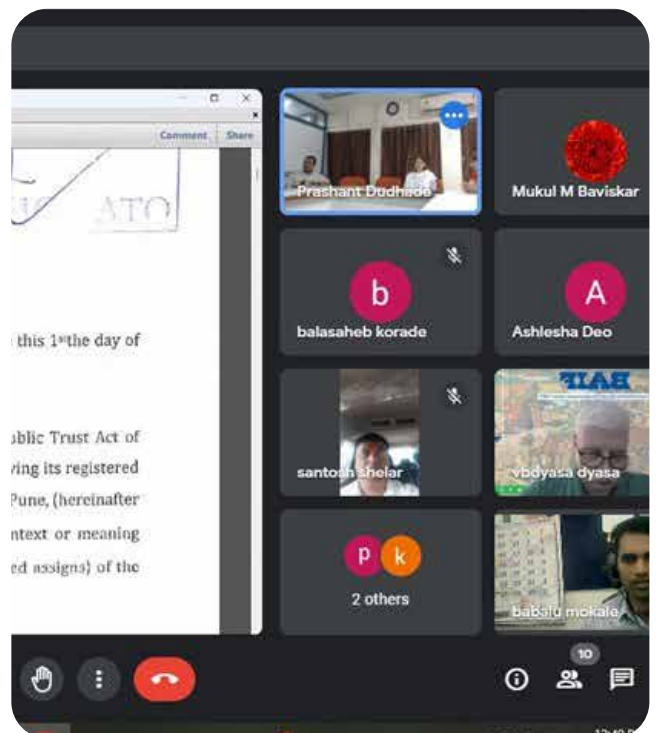
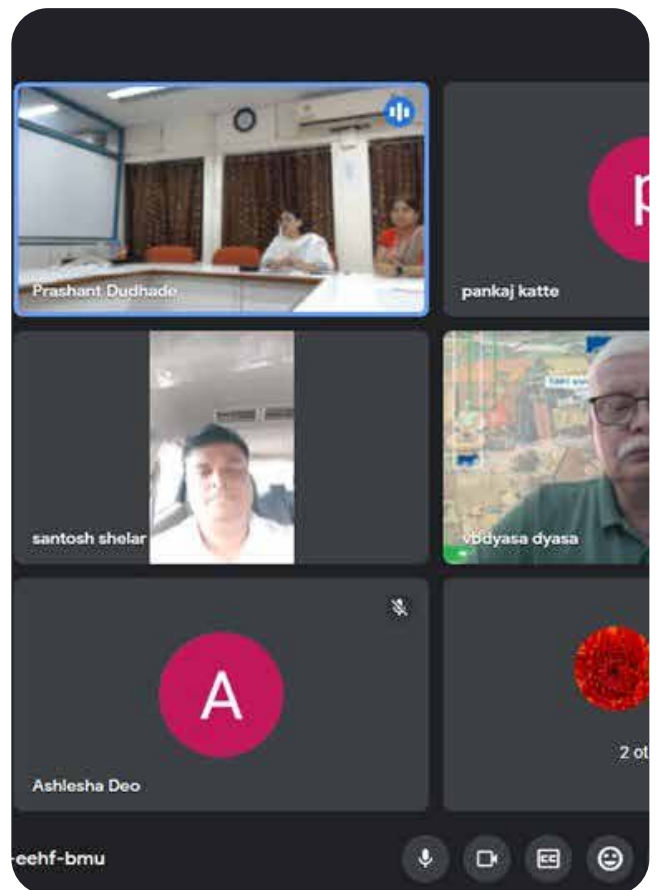
HARITA – Catalysing Sustainable Ecosystem and Economic Wellbeing of rural women in Khandala Blocks of Satara districts in Maharashtra
Mukul Madhav Foundation collaborated with BAIF Institute for Sustainable Livelihoods and Development (BISLD) for The Project HARITA.
Project Outreach- 300 Women farmers in 3 villages (Javale, Vaogaon and Mirje)

Objective of the project :

- To introduce a model of women-centric, women-led development for socio-economic health and nutrition gains
- To empower farm women by introducing activities focusing on a demonstration plot
- Conducting financial literacy programs to help young women understand family budgets, income and expenditures, savings plans and savings monitoring, and investment planning
- Promotion of farm, off-farm, and non-farm entrepreneurship
- Linking smart micro-entrepreneurship with govt scheme and CSR

In this project, Mukul Madhav Foundation will cover 300 women for entrepreneurship development activities and make women entrepreneurs in the field of Agri and non-agri sector.

Till date Mukul Madhav Foundation has supported more than 4000 such mammographies by organising such camps.

Inauguration of this camp was held on 25th October 2023 at the hands of Mrs Dhanashri Karanjikar, PSI Sawarde, Mrs Albur Madam wife of Mr Albur, President Operation Finolex industries and Dr Suvarna Patil Medical Director Walavalkar Hospital. Training on Banking Services, SHGs, MSMEs, Government Schemes for Women, Financial Awareness, and Savings for Women of Gavasad Tailoring Classes (Near FIL Masar).

Mukul Madhav Foundation, initiated holistic development through training for the women of Gavasad Village, including tailoring classes.

Mukul Madhav Foundation will conduct awareness training for the tailoring students, covering topics such as health, basic first aid, personal grooming, hygiene, personality development, communication skills, the importance of education for children, banking services and their benefits, and entrepreneurship for tailoring. This project aims -

- To empower female members of Mauli Seva Pratishthan Ahmednagar with the necessary skills required to set up a dairy processing unit on a small scale.
- The women entrepreneurs/ dairy farmers will gain a good understanding of how they can scale up their production over time using different kinds of equipment.
- Ladies of Mauli Seva Pratishthan will be fully trained in milk processing, packaging, making business plans, and soft skills to manage their business.

School transformation project agreement Signed for Educational Development in Koppal District, 25th October, 2023

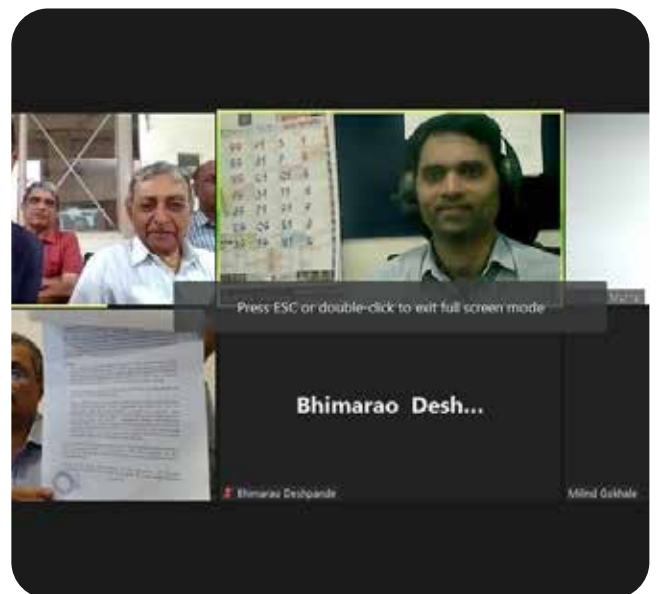
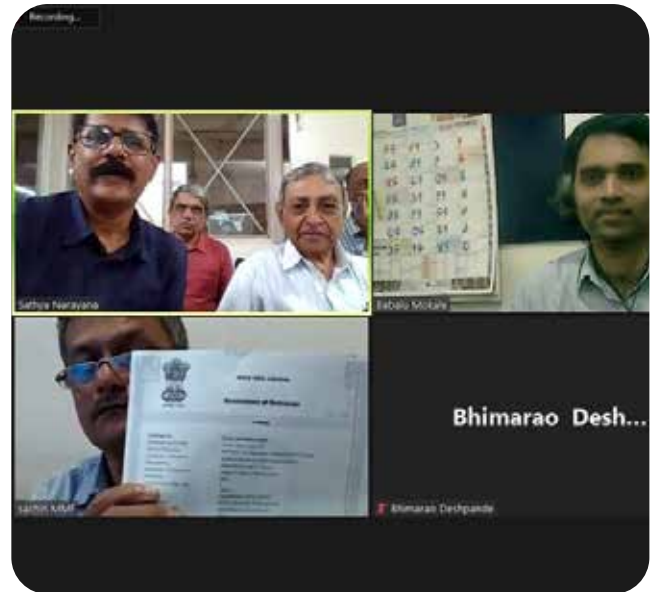
Mukul Madhav Foundation, signed an agreement with Samarpaka Trust for a School Transformation project in the Koppal District of Karnataka. Children in Koppal District were benefitted by the support provided to schools, including Sanitation blocks, ROs, Desks, and Play equipment.

The signing ceremony was conducted on 25th Oct. 2023 in the presence of Mr. Rahul Pandey IAS Chief Executive Officer Zilla Panchayat Koppal, Mr. Rajanna Trustee Samarpaka, Mr. Sachin Kulkarni Sr. Member of Mukul Madhav Foundation, Mr. Vivek Mrunal Finolex Industries Karnataka and Team Mukul Madhav Foundation and Samarpaka.

In the first phase, in 2022-23, Mukul Madhav Foundation supported with 41 new toilets and Govt schools of Magadi Taluka of Ramanagara District, along with RO filters, and benches which benefitted 11,763 beneficiaries.

This year Mukul Madhav Foundation is supporting 43 schools with 30 Sanitation blocks, 36 ROs, 720 Desks, and 2 schools with Play equipment which will impact and benefit 14000 children in Koppal District.

This project is appreciated by CEO Koppal and was made possible through the ground support from local government authority.



Support for National TB elimination program by providing nutrition kits in Vadodara District

In line with the National TB Elimination Programme (NTEP), which aims to eliminate TB by 2025 as announced by the Honourable Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modi, Mukul Madhav Foundation joined hands with the Vadodara District TB Department in March 2023 to provide support through Nutrition Kits. After six months, MMF has once again taken a pledge to renew and continue support until March 2024.

The Nutrition Kits, as suggested by the TB District Department, includes 1 KG of Tuver Dal, 1 KG of Mug, 1 KG of Groundnut, 1 KG of Jaggery, 1 KG of Chana, 1 Litre of Edible Oil, 400 Grams of Protein Milk Powder, and 1 KG of Dates.
