More than 200 children from Ratnagiri district have been screened periodically by Neuro Surgeons, Orthopedists, Physiotherapists, Occupational Therapists, Speech Therapists, Orthotists and Optometrists from reputed hospitals in Pune including Sancheti Hospital, Bharti Hospital, KEM Hospital, Dinanath Mangeshkar and HV Desai Eye Hospital organized camps and examined children with cerebral palsy.

162 seniors screened at Geriatric Camp 30th January, 2024

MMF/FIL conducted its 6th geriatric camp on 30th January at sub PHC Dhom, Wai, where a total of 162 patients were screened. Out of these, 17 patients were referred to dental treatment, 19 to ENT treatment, more than 110 patients took physiotherapy and orthopedic advice, 25 referred for cataract surgery, 10 patients received spectacles, 3 senior citizens (women) diagnosed with other problems. Every patient checked their blood pressure, CBC, calcium and sugar level.

Post this camp, on 6thFeb 2024, 15 cataract surgeries were done along with two life-saving surgeries.





25 juvenile diabetics supported in Maharashtra 1st February, 2024

Agriculture-based Training programme for jail inmates 22nd February, 2024

Agriculture Best Practices: Teaching inmates about agriculture best practices involves educating them on efficient and sustainable farming techniques. This may include soil management, crop rotation, pest and disease control, irrigation methods, and harvesting techniques.

Farm Allied Business: This will involve teaching inmates about agricultural entrepreneurship, such as setting up and managing farm-based businesses like livestock farming, dairy farming, and poultry farming

Nursery Development: involves the cultivation and management of plant nurseries, where young plants are grown for transplantation. Inmates can learn about the propagation of various plants, including trees, shrubs, flowers, and vegetables.



Vermicomposting: Inmates will be trained in vermicomposting techniques, including how to set up and maintain vermicomposting systems, manage organic waste inputs, and harvest compost.

Overall, training inmates in agriculture and related practices offers a constructive way to occupy their time, fosters personal development, and equips them with valuable skills that can increase their chances of successful reintegration into society upon release.

Providing Nutrition 22nd February, 2024

In March 2020, Mukul Madhav Foundation had distributed 10 SciTech Soyamate machines at Mokhada Palghar in collaboration with Science and Technology Park Pune, identifying and training Primary school teachers in association with Karmveer Bhaurao Patil High School. ON 22nd Feb, we gave these machines a new lease of life by training more people in use of these machines, and it benefits. Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, Satara through their Arts, Science and Commerce College, Mokhada supported the implementation of this project in Palghar. The soymilk extracted through Soymate is fortified with jaggery, or any kind of essence like chocolate, rose, or Flaxseed (a rich source of Omega 3 Fatty Acid) and is then given to children below 5 years of age. Soymilk has specific health benefits to prevent malnutrition in children including proper body growth and immunity building.
