This year we had plenty orders in which some orders are by our guests too.

Orders completed by women

1700bags ordered by Reshmi Didwaniya for which raw materials were provided by herself and 800 Potli bag ,1800 Shopping bag ordered by Nidhi Agrawal (Jalan synthetic).

Profit of bag's was 12rs/bag so total profit by bags is 12*1700= 20400,shopping bag profit was 35rs/pec so the profit by shopping bag is 800*35=28000 and Potli bag's profit was 15rs/pic the total profit of Potli bag's is 1800*15=27000,100 pec kurta-Pajama ordered by ISKCON Temple and the profit of one pec Kurta-pajama was 150 rs./pec so total profit by Kurtha-Pajama is 100pec*150rs=15000 So the overall total profit by the all the orders in this year was ₹ 90400.

What is the Mile-stone challenges and achievements to run this centre:-

Milestone - Opening this sewing center for our organization would have been quite challenging without your support. This sewing center is running smoothly, thanks to your assistance, and so far, 40 individuals have been trained, with 20 currently undergoing training, and 20 skilled individuals producing various items (bags, pouches, petticoats, wedding attire). Finding a market for these items crafted by these women was initially difficult, but despite the challenges, we have identified a good market. In the upcoming financial year 2024-2025, our goal is to provide training to an additional 40 women.

Challenges - Providing training to rural women who had no means of employment and transforming them into capable individuals to support their families was challenging. Selling the items crafted by these women in the market posed difficulties, but our team managed to find a good market after overcoming various obstacles.

Achievement - So far, we have successfully trained 40 individuals for self-employment. We have also fulfilled orders for various items, such as bags, pouches, petticoats, blouses, wedding attire, kurta-pajamas, etc., received from the Varanasi Municipal Commissioner and several organizations in Banaras
