

3. BACKGROUND

Palliative care aims at improving the quality of life of a patient who is suffering from a chronic serious ailment like that of advanced cancer. Nobody wants to be away from their family, when they have came to know that their loved one is going to leave this world soon. A patient gets the best comfort when the treatment is given at his own home and that too by his close ones. When palliative care is provided at the patient's home, it provides a sense of safety, privacy, confidentiality and peace of mind for the patient .It is provided by a team of trained members which includes doctor , nurse , social worker, volunteers, physiotherapist etc. They pay regular visits at home of the patient and provide necessary health care to the patient.

The data available with Tamil Nadu Cancer Registry Program says that there are nearly 2000 new cancer cases reported every year from Kanniyakumari District. As a result, a minimum of 500 patients enters into the advanced stage of their cancer every year. At this stage, the chance for cure is less and palliative care is the only option.

Sreeram cancer Trust has been providing Home based palliative care since 2011. And the demand for the home care is high in the society, Sreeram Cancer Trust has trained staff, but don't have vehicle for home visits. The trust approached M/s.Mukul Madhav Foundation the CSR Partner of M/s.FINOLEX industries.M/s. Mukul Madhav Foundation happily accepted the request and donated one Maruti Eeco van to Sreeram Cancer Trust.

Sreeram cancer trust started home visits using the vehicle immediately. The vehicle helps a lot in home visits. It is used to pick Doctor, Nurses ,social workers ,volunteers and the entire team to the house of patients. This helps to reach more than 2 patients in a single day . The vehicle plays a vital role in visiting patients in long distance (i.e 35 to 40 kms) from the center.

Today (23.02.2023) District Collector Thiru. P.N. Sridhar, IAS, flagged off the free pain relief treatment and home care vehicle for cancer patients at Kanniyakumari District Collector Office premises. Sreeram Cancer Trust has been providing various assistance to cancer sufferers in Kanyakumari district for the past 16 years. Since 2011, it has been providing free palliative care and home care. Funds for such services are raised through public donations and donations from large corporates, Pune-headquartered Finolex Pipes and its social responsibility organization Mukul Madhav Foundation have donated a vehicle worth Rs 6 lakh to Sreeram Cancer Trust. A team of doctors, nurses, psychologists and social workers will work in this homecare vehicle. Also, Sreeram Cancer Trust will provide free pain relief and home care to cancer patients for those who have been prescribed pain relief by a doctor, who have severe pain due to cancer, stage IV patients, cancer patients in more than one location, bedridden patients and those who have been informed that there is no more medical treatment available. The service of the vehicle has been launched today and those suffering from cancer pain are requested to contact Sreeram Cancer Trust on 890 35 35 945 to avail the scheme. 6. UPDATE ON ACTIVITIES

The inauguration of the program was on 23-2-2023. Immediately after the inauguration Sreeram Cancer Trust started home visits for the patients already registered with them. Usually ,the trust uses auto rickshaw ,private cab or public transport for the purpose of visiting patients. Now ,the Eeco van donated by Mukul Madhav Foundation is used to visit patients at their home.

- 4. The vehicle is very much useful in visiting patients at long distance. That is 35 to 50 kms away from our center.
- 5. This service will continue and reach more patients in the coming years.

A free home for terminally ill Cancer patients

Introduction

The Divine Grace of Bhagavan Sri Ramana Maharshi led us to plan a home for cancer patients. This is a home of compassionate care and support for cancer patients. The center will provide pain medicines, nursing care, in patient care, home care, spiritual support, complementary therapies and bereavement care. The palliative center is a 25 bed in-patient facility. The center will be established in Kanniyakumari District. And the center will be like **Karunashraya** in Bangalore, **CIPLA Palliative care center** in Pune.

Objectives of the new project

- 1. The main objective is to establish a 25 bedded charitable Palliative care center in the name "Bhagavan Sri Ramana Maharshi"
- 2. To provide quality In-patient care.
- 3. To provide Home care services
- 4. Training programs for health care professionals.
- 5. To establish a Center for excellence

Present facility at Sri Ramana Palliative Care Center, Nagercoil

At present, Sri Ramana Palliative care center is functioning at a rented building at Basement floor ,Chellaram Hospital Building, Thottiyodu Junction,Kanniyakumari District. The center was inaugurated on 25-11-2021 with the support of M/s East West Integrative Research Institute Pvt.Ltd, Chennai. At present it functions as a day care center. It can admit 8 patients comfortably.

Why we need this new facility

Sri Ramana Palliative Care Center is currently functioning in a rented building as a Day care center with limited bed facility. It is difficult to provide complete care to the patient at this facility.

The new facility can provide round the clock in-patient care to the patients. Our 25 bed center is designed to provide personalised care to the patients in a lush green homely environment.

It is estimated that 80-100 palliative care beds are needed for 10,00,000 inhabitants (as per European studies).

Financials of the project

The budgeted cost of this project including purchase of land , civil construction and all furniture is Rs.4 crores. By the grace of Sri Bhagavan , many philanthropists and companies are coming forward to support this project.
