Inaugurated renovated shelter for homeless in Kolhapur 26th March, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries, recently renovated the Shelter home of Kolhapur Municipal Corporation. The inauguration on 26th March was attended by Mr. Atul Gabale, Sales Representative, Finolex Industries Limited Kolhapur, Ms. Swati Shah, Community Organizer NULM (National Urban Livelihood Mission), Ms. Vrushali Patil – City Livelihood Center Manager Kolhapur and KMC representatives.









Supported research on geriatric women in rural Maharashtra 26th March, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries joined hands with SNDT Women's University Pune Campus to facilitate and work on Research on Geriatric Women Population in Rural Maharashtra - a Post COVID Socio-psychological Study.

Covering a sample size of 10,000 elderly women in rural areas across 36 districts in Maharashtra, this study will help the government in renewing current policies and creating new policies for the marginalized women population.

This report was completed and presented to MMF/FIL on 26th March 2024, in the presence of Dr. Sachin Deore Principal of SNDT Pune, Ms. Lily Shulka Sr. Manager Finance Finolex Industries Limited, Ms. Yasmin Shaikh and Mr. Babalu Mokale from Mukul Madhav Foundation, and Faculty of SNDT. It was later published on 3rd April 2024, at SNDT College in the presence of VC SNDT and dignitaries from MMF/FIL. SNDT Women's University Pune is the first Women's university in India as well as in South-East Asia. SNDT 32nd Women's University stands amonast multi-disciplinary universities of India and ranked fourth in Western India according to the Week-Hansa Research ranking of 2020.

Inaugurated shed for students to have midday meals 26th March, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries supported the Zilla Parishad School Ravangaon in Maharashtra with a shed for mid-day meals for students. The shed was inaugurated in the presence of Mr. Nilesh Ghule Sales Representative Finolex Industries Limited, the School Principal and teachers of Zilla Parishad School Ravangaon. This shed will help children to sit and have lunch, and also be useful for school programs.




Made water accessible to wildlife in Kumbhalgad Wildlife Sanctuary 29th March, 2024

At Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries, we have always shown compassion to all living things - humans, cows, birds, horses. We have also made water accessible to farmers, schools, villages, trees, crops and now to wild animals with the recent signing of an agreement with Earth Brigade Foundation to provide water to wildlife in Kumbhalgad wildlife sanctuary, Ranakpur Rajasthan.

We facilitated the installation of solar powered pumpsets at wells in the remote areas of the forest. The pumps will work without electricity, to replenish water in the surface waterbodies, by pulling water up from the wells there. This water will quench the thirst of the surrounding wildlife, as well as the staff posted there in these grueling summer months.

In the absence of accessible water, wild animals wander into human settlements in search of the same. Hence these pumps will also avoid human-wildlife conflict. A win-win for all.





Inaugurated facilities to impact 5543 students in Bihar and Rajasthan 30th March, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries extended their support to 17 government schools in Buxar – Bihar and Kota – Rajasthan.

Inaugurating the various facilities on 30th March 2024 in the presence of Mr. Ashutosh Kulkarni, VP-PPC in Buxar Bihar, and Mr. Pushpendra Singh General Manager - Analytics in Kota Rajasthan from Finolex Industries Limited along with the school Principals, teachers, students, and team Yuva Unstoppable.

With 7 schools in Buxar - 14 toilets, 7 dishwashing areas, 7 drinking water areas, and 7 midday meal sheds. And 10 schools in Kota - 20 toilets, 10 dishwashing areas, 10 drinking water areas, and 10 midday meal sheds. Benefiting 2436 students in Buxar Bihar and 3107 students in Kota Rajasthan





In the 1st Phase of collaboration with Yuva Unstoppable, MMF/FIL supported 9 government schools in Lucknow. As per the appeal and request done by Shri Yogi Adityanath ji, Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh we supported 13 toilets for both boys and girls, 9 drinking water areas, 6 midday meal sheds, and 7 dishwashing areas. In both phases, the entire work of refurbishment, new tiling, new hardware, and other such support has been provided to benefit 5491 students which is fully funded by Finolex Industries.

Extended NiKshay support to 50 TB patients in Uttar Pradesh 30th March, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries supports the government initiative of Nikshay in Maharashtra and Gujarat, and on 30th March 2024 extended this support to Mirzapur, Uttar Pradesh. Distributed nutritional kits with the ground support of Hope Welfare Trust Varanasi in line with the National TB Elimination Programme (NTEP), which aims to eliminate TB by 2025 as announced by the Honorable Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modi.

Supported construction work at Autism Centre 2nd April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries supported ARC - Autism Research and Training Centre, with plumbing pipes for their construction work. The Autism Centre is a residential home for children who are identified as autistic, with more than 200 children benefiting from the centre.

363 people to benefit from blood donated by FIL/MMF employees 5th April, 2024 /19th April, 2024

Over two days in April, across five locations, employees at Mukul Madhav Foundation and Finolex Pipes at Urse, and Ratnagiri responded to a call for blood donations by local blood banks.

A total of 160 employees stepped forward to donate in spite of various other programmes and commitments. Out of these, 39 were not accepted for donation due to high blood pressure, or low HB. The other 121 donated blood, where each bag of blood will now go on to help three patients.



5th April, blood donation camp at Finolex Pipe, Urse through Inlaks and Budhrani hospital blood bank. 19th April, blood donation camps in Ratnagiri at Finolex Industries, Finolex Phase 3 colony, Finolex Phase 2 colony and Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya. Through VaibhaviLaxmi Blood Bank and Indian Red Cross association.

All participating blood banks thanked FIL and MMF for organising such blood camps and thereby helping society.



Supports 50 children with Type 1 Diabetes in Coimbatore 5th April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries will now support 50 children with Type 1 Diabetes in Coimbatore through the Idhayangal Charitable Foundation.




We are currently supporting children with type 1 diabetes in the following regions

•Maharashtra: - KEM Hospital Pune (30 children), Jalgaon (70 Children), Daund (27 children) Karad –Satara 27 Children

- •Gujarat: Vadodara (27 children)
- •Tamil Nadu: 20:- Vellore, Madurai, Coimbatore, Thanjavur

In total MMF/FIL supports 201 children every month







Moreover, by maintaining a balanced ecosystem, this project will contribute to the overall health and sustainability of the Ranakpur Wildlife Sanctuary.

MMF always believes in creating sustainable, ongoing impactful projects. This initiative stands as a testament to that commitment, demonstrating how collaborative efforts can make a lasting difference in wildlife conservation and ecosystem preservation.

Solar Pumpset Installation in Ranakpur Wildlife Sanctuary 5th April, 2024

On April 4th, 2024, Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries and Capricot Technologies collaborated with Earth Bridge Foundation to install two solar water pump sets in the Ranakpur Wildlife Sanctuary. The installation of these solar pump sets is expected to have a profound impact on the sanctuary's ecosystem. Located at Pipla Chowkie and Pagpawti, these two sites will provide water storage at five different locations within the sanctuary.

With this initiative, more than 10,000 wild animals will benefit directly, as their thirst will be quenched without the need for migration. This will, in turn, reduce inter-animal conflicts and minimize conflicts between wildlife and human settlements, particularly those residing near the forest.

Agreement Signed for Rural Livelihood and Entrepreneur Support for Women 15th April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, in collaboration with FICCI Flo Pune Chapter, signed an agreement with BAIF Development Research Foundation to support rural livelihood and empower women entrepreneurs in Uruli Kanchan, Pune. The partnership aims to address socio-economic challenges and promote sustainable development in the region.

Key Objectives:

- Enhancing rural livelihood opportunities.
- •Empowering women through entrepreneurship.
- •Fostering economic growth and community development in Uruli Kanchan.

The signing ceremony was attended by Ms. Ritu Prakash Chhabria Vertical Head Rural Livelihood / Entrepreneurship and GB Member FICCI Flo, Ms. Pinky Rajpal Chairperson Flo Pune. Ms. Gauri Dholepatil, Ms. Pooja Anand, and Ms. Gayatri Ghule as members of Flo Pune, Ms. Rajashree Joshi Director of BAIF, with BAIF team, and Mr. Sachin Kulkarni with team MMF.



Overall, the event marked a significant step towards fostering inclusive development and empowering women in Uruli Kanchan, Pune, through collaborative efforts between corporate, Foundation, and NGO partners.

Donated medical equipment for labor room at Symbiosis Hospital 16th April, 2024

Symbiosis Hospital, Lavale, Taluka Mulshi, Dist. Pune recently received a donation of medical equipment for its NICU to mark the birth anniversary of our founder on 12th March 2024. This was the first step Mukul Madhav Foundation took here as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited.




600 families in dry region receive 5000 liters water at doorstep 18th April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries responded to a request for drinking water facilities by Sarpanch of Phansop and Bhatye village. Due to geographical constraints, availability of potable water is acute in these regions. We provided 2 water tankers of 5000 liters' capacity, that delivered water right to their doorsteps, benefiting approx. 600 families. This is the eight year running for this scheme. On 18th April 2024, this initiative was inaugurated at Phansop village in the presence of Sarpanch of Phansop and Bhatye villages, Government authorities, Gram Panchayat members, villagers, representatives of FIL and MMF.

Sarpanch of both the villages and Gram Panchayat members expressed heartfelt gratitude to FIL and MMF for the continued support of these villages with water facilities, specially during summer.





60 women and adolescent girls to receive Beautician and Wellness Training 18th April, 2024

As part of our drive to empower marginalised women with livelihood training, Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited signed an agreement with Samarpaka for the Women Livelihood-Beautician and Wellness initiative in selected Talukas/Towns of Chikkaballapur district (60 Kms from Bangalore).

The agreement was signed on 18th April in the presence of Ritu Prakash Chhabria-Managing Trustee Mukul Madhav Foundation with Team MMF and Mr. Rajanna S. Managing Trustee Samarpaka with Team. Covering 60 women and adolescent girls in 10 batches, the project aims to improve the economic conditions of these families by improving employability among the rural and semi-urban communities. Working out a sustainable model for the communities to manage their livelihood, by empowering and training women to take up employment in different areas.

Safeguarding 120 girls and 25 young women in Delhi NCR 18th April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited and FLO (FICCI Ladies Organisation) signed an agreement with RCI (Railway Children India) to safeguard girls and young women in vulnerable communities around Delhi.

The agreement was signed with Navin Sellaraju Sukumar, CEO, Railway Children India, Nitin Aggarwal, Head of Finance and Admin, RCI, Joyshree Das Verma, President FLO 2024-2025, Rashmi Sarita, Executive Director, FLO, Ritu Prakash Chhabria, Managing Trustee Mukul Madhav Foundation, National Head, Rural Livelihood / Entrepreneurship and MMF team RCI has identified 120 girls and 25 women in Tulasinagar (Delhi NCR) facing exposure to various forms of abuse, domestic violence, and gender discrimination.



With this group, the following will be ensured as outcomes

•The right to education, health (Including mental health), nutrition, protection, safeguarding, and participation are effectively ensured for all 120 girls

(No school dropout, no child labor, no child marriage, no missing girl child, no girl becoming victim of online sexual exploitation)

•25 women are empowered to address challenges and protect their adolescent girls. (Women link with livelihood opportunities, safeguard their girls from risk and vulnerabilities, women become the role of the community, improve parenting skills of women)

To ensure the above, the following will be actioned:-

- •Social Inclusion camps in collaboration with District Legal Service Authorities (DLSA) for government schemes
- ·Establish Market linked small enterprises
- ·Workshops on Parenting Skills
- ·Health camps in collaboration with Health care NGOs
- Adult literacy program
- •Women linked withLegal and medical aid through mega medico-legal camps
- -Employee Engagement activities
- Motivational Storytelling
- •Group Activities on the Importance of Education
- ·Life skill training
- •Mentoring youth who are getting enrolled in vocational training
- •Training session on child safeguarding and Community awareness program







Water conservation projects inaugurated in three villages in Solapur 19th April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited works extensively in environmental sustainability and supporting villages with water conservation projects.

On April 19, 2024, MMF/FIL signed an agreement with Katfal village, Solapur district to construct a new Cement Nala Bandh, repair the old Cement Nala Bandh, and Deepen the existing well.

The ceremony was attended by several notable figures including Sarpanch Adv. Vijay Kharat, Birdev Kharat, and Maruti Pujari, Mr. Santosh Shelar from Finolex Industries Limited. Additionally, Gramsevak Mr. Burungale was also present during the inauguration.

Water project agreement signing and inauguration was also done at Gholeswar and Konikonur village.

Sarpanch of both villages and villagers were present for the inauguration program. Villagers and farmers are thankful to MMF for valuable water conservation work in their villages.



57 screenings done at Mammography Camp 18th, 19th, 20th April 2024

A three-day mammography camp was conducted at Bharati Hospital where a total of 57 screenings and testings were done.

Every month MMF/FIL conducts Mammography and Cervical cancer camps at Bharati Hospital with a daily average of 20 beneficiaries above 35 years.
